Statement	STSBHN realizes the need to transport objects to support academic achievement. Transportation must be done in a way that ensures safety for all riders. At no time shall firearms or any objects that are dangerous be transported with students.
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Skates - Skate blades shall be covered by guards, tied together and carried in a bag. The skates shall be placed on the floor of the bus at the student's feet. 2. Skis and Poles - Skis and ski poles may be transported on a school bus only if they are properly bound and stored in an open seat. A bus that is equipped with suitable storage space under the floor of the bus is the preferred location for such objects and should be requested whenever possible. 3. Hockey Equipment - Hockey equipment may be transported on a school bus only if it is properly bound and stored in an open seat. A bus that is equipped with suitable storage space under the floor of the bus is the preferred location for such objects and should be requested whenever possible. 4. Musical Instruments - Musical instruments may be transported if they can be kept on the student's lap. Larger instruments may be transported on a school bus only if they are properly bound and stored in an open seat. 5. Skateboards/Scooters/Roller Blades - Skateboards, scooters, and roller blades shall not be transported on a school bus unless properly stored in a bag. 6. Pets - Pets shall not be transported on a school bus with the exception of service animals in accordance with (039) Transporting Students with Service Animals. 7. Other - The decision to transport other objects to and/or from schools shall be determined in advance by the principal with STSBHN's input.
